/ OVERVIEW

Christopher Sealey DJ's using a Serato Scratch Live (www.serato.com/scratchlive) setup. The below equipment list assumes plugging in to house sound system via XLR output directly from Rane TTM 57 DJ Mixer. In the case of private events, additional speaker rentals may be necessary.

/ EQUIPMENT MAKES AND MODELS

Please note that equipment brands, makes, or models other than the below will not be considered suitable without prior authorization. Further, it is assumed that monitor speaker, DJ table, and house sound system will be set up by house audio staff prior to event.

DJ Mixer: One (1) - Rane TTM57SL Mixer | <http://bit.ly/1PIgR2>

Vinyl Turntables: Two (2) - Technics 1200MK5 | <http://bit.ly/3IQZs>

Alternate Option Two (2) - Technics 1200MK2 | <http://bit.ly/2luKy>

Setup: Turntables should be set up sideways with the tonearm at the top (and the mixer in between). It is preferable that turntables be placed in individual DJ coffins, but turntables placed directly on table or other playing surface are also acceptable.

Alternate Option Two (2) - Pioneer CDJ-2000 | <http://bit.ly/pmSsbz>

Additional Items:

- One (1) - DJ monitor speaker. (Mackie, Alesis, JBL, etc)
- One (1) - Shure microphone (if necessary for event).
- One (1) - DJ performance table. (Approx 3.5' high (waist height) x 2.5' deep x 6' wide).
- Two (2) - Surge protector power strips. (Minimum of 6 available outlets)
- One (1) - roll black electrical tape
- Two (2) to Four (4) - JBL EON 15" Powered speakers (if event requires additional speakers)
